
The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin and Tetramethrin Interim Decisions and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use this product in its original container with the affixed trigger sprayer.

Use Restrictions:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact children, adults, workers, or other persons, either directly or through drift. Do not apply when food is present. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not apply when food is present. Do not wet articles to point of run-off or drip and do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces.

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems and in metered release systems. Do not apply on plants or vegetation. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.

To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

A READY-TO-USE INSECTICIDE

INDOORS

COCKROACHES (including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant and organophosphate and carbamate resistant strains). **ANTS, BOOKLICE, BOXELDER BUGS, CENTIPEDES, CRICKETS, DERMESTIDS, FIREBRANTS, FLEAS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, TICKS AND WATERBUGS:** Apply thoroughly by spraying until damp to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases, and areas where they occur.

ANTS: Spray until damp around ant trails, doors and windows, and other places where ants enter premises. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, and other objects where ants occur. Break apart accessible nests and spray on and around their debris.

CARPENTER ANTS: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply until damp around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings.

BROWN DOG TICKS and FLEAS in buildings: Apply until damp in infested areas including pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pest occur. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not use directly on pets.

SPIDERS: Apply until damp along and behind baseboards, to window and doorframes, comers, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may be present.

CENTIPEDES, EARWIGS, GROUND BEETLES, MILLIPEDES, MOLE CRICKETS, PILLBUGS, SOWBUGS, SCORPIONS, and TICKS: Apply until damp around doors windows and other places where these pests enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas, and other locations where these pests are found.

PANTRY PESTS-GRAIN BEETLES (RUSTY, MERCHANT and SAW- TOOTHED), FLOUR BEETLES (RED AND CONFUSED) CHOCOLATE MOTHS, CIGARETTE BEETLES, CLOVER MITES, CLUSTER FLIES, DRUG STORE BEETLES, ELMLEAF BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, LESSER GRAIN BORERS, SPIDER BEETLES and TOBACCO MOTHS: Treat exposed stages of these pests. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray until damp to shelves and crack and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

CARPET BEETLES (BLACK, FURNITURE and VARIED): Spray until damp on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

WEBBING CLOTHES MOTHS: Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. This is an adjunct treatment and will not control moth larvae already on clothes. Do not apply to clothing.

OUTDOORS

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For the control of building infestation due to **ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES,** and **SOWBUGS (PILLBUGS).** Spray foundation of building until damp where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 feet. Apply as a spray to outside of buildings where insects congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, garages, and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: ANTS, COCKROACHES (including ASIAN COCKROACHES) CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES and SILVERFISH. Spray infested surface until damp of patio or picnic area, contacting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray anthills for best control.

ANTS, LONE STAR TICKS, DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, FLEAS and EARWIGS: Apply thoroughly until damp to infestations. For ants, spray around ant trails and hills.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL AND CONTAINER HANDLINE: If empty:

(pints/quarts) Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. **(1-gal size)** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container $\frac{1}{4}$ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank for store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available or reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
