The submission referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Revise your disposal statement to read:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

(For metal containers)

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

(For plastic containers)

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

The heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" must be of the same type size as the child hazard warning statement.

- b. Delete "Sodium Carbonate" and "Essential Oils" from the active ingredients. They are now considered inert ingredients. Adjust your inert percentages accordingly.
- c. Delete the phenol coefficients claims.
- d. Delete the words sanitizes and sanitizer from the label.
- e. Revise the referral statement to read:

- f. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be placed directly above the signal word "DANGER" (center panel only).
- g. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER**  
**Keep Out of Reach of Children**

- h. Change "Use Directions" to "Directions For Use" and include the following misuse statement directly below to read:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.


- i. Include a 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section.
- j. Delete the word "milk."
- k. Change the "First Aid" heading to "Statement of Practical Treatment."
- l. Revise the sentence "a pre-cleaning step is recommended" to "a pre-cleaning step is required."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

### USE DIRECTIONS:

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will provide 500 ppm quaternary to the use solution. This is enough for general disinfection, fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi and deodorizing.

For best results, use TRIO with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, table tops, counters and garbage pails.

For use in hospitals, 3 ounces per gallon will be required for disinfection against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

For heavy soil, a pre-cleaning step is recommended before using TRIO.

### PHENOL COEFFICIENTS:

GUARANTEED	MINIMUM
<i>S. aureus</i>	30
<i>S. typhosa</i>	19

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

TRIO is a cleaner, disinfectant for general household use. For use on walls, floors, faces. When used, disinfect those areas which get smelly, such as garbage room areas which are prone to growth of some micro-organisms such as *Staphylococcus aureus* at 2 ounces per gallon dilution. Trichophyton.

Effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* at 3 ounces per gallon for disinfection.

In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician. Remove and discard before reuse. If swallowed, give a gelatin solution, or if in large quantities of water...
