

DIRECTIONS: Manufactured and sold for use in Auto Chlor Systems only. Equipment adjusted to provide 1/2 ounce of sanitizer per gallon of water. Allow utensils to remain immersed for 1 to 2 minutes (as required by local health departments) for full sanitizing. Rinse utensils in potable water. This product meets the criteria of Appendix F of Order A. Pasteurized Milk Ordinance, 1945 Recommendation of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 500 ppm (32 grains per gallon) hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when tested by the AOAC Microbiological and Detergent Sanitizing Official Method.
