

DIRECTIONS: To wash walls, floors, tables, woodwork, refrigerators, bathroom fixtures and garbage cans, mix one ounce DS-33 per gallon of water. To disinfect mix 2 1/2 ounces of DS-33 per gallon of water for non-porous surfaces. For porous surfaces mix 3 ounces DS-33 per gallon of water. Apply with mop, sponge, brush or spray.
