The amendment submitted in connection with the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes below:

1. Delete the heading "Sanitizer" from the label. No data has been submitted to support the use of this product as a sanitizer for nonfood contact surfaces.
2. Delete the heading "Deodorizer". No use directions have been provided for deodorization.
3. Change "Hazards To Humans and Animals" to "Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals".
4. Include the phrase "Precautionary Statements" immediately above the "Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals" statement.
5. Revise your storage and disposal statement to read;

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage disposal, open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these

wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

(for metal containers)

Triple rinse (or Equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities

(for plastic containers)

Triple rinse (or Equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

The heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" must be of the same size as the child hazard warning statement.

5. Delete the phrase "(First Aid)".
6. Capitalize all of the letters in "Active Ingredient" and "Inert Ingredient". Indent the chemical name under the heading "Active Ingredient".
7. Change "Practical Treatment" to "Statement of Practical Treatment".


Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS

DANGER

Regular and frequent applications are more efficient and practical than irregular cleaning.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Auto-Chlor DS-33 is a product especially prepared for use in restaurants, hospitals, schools, and various institutions. It is a detergent or disinfectant.

As a detergent, Auto-Chlor DS-33 is used for washing floors, tile, gratings, bathroom fixtures, etc., by mixing 1 fl. oz. with one gallon of water. For surfaces such as brick, tile, etc., use 3 oz. per gallon mixture.

As a disinfectant, use a dilution of at least 1/2 oz. of DS-33 per gallon of water. Applied with a cloth, mop, brush to previously cleaned walls, countertops, bedframes, chairs, garbage pails, and non-porous surfaces. Surfaces are thoroughly wet and remain wet for 10 minutes. Level of DS-33 as a disinfectant in these directions is effective against staphylococcus aureus, choleraesuis, and aeruginosa. Fresh solution prepared daily or sooner becomes visibly dirty. Surfaces are visible after treated and dried, mop, wipe, or rinse with water.
