

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION of hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial and commercial offices, restrooms and work area.

CLEANING AND DEODORIZING. Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 5 to 8 ounces of **MINT-O-LAV** per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING. Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 5 ounces of **MINT-O-LAV** per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. This disinfecting solution must contact the surfaces for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OF GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT. It is especially important to pre-clean, in order for the disinfectant to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of **MINT-O-LAV** per gallon of water.

FOR CLEANING OF WALLS, FLOORS AND INDUSTRIAL WORK AREAS. Use 5 to 8 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for personnel doing continuous hand cleaning.

MINT-O-LAV is also an excellent deodorant. It is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin.

MINT-O-LAV mixes readily with water and makes a clear stable solution. In use dilution it is non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals. Has a pleasant mint odor. **MINT-O-LAV** may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment. **MINT-O-LAV** must not be used on food contact surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store only in tightly closed, original container in a secure area inaccessible to children and away from food and feed. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and Local authorities. If container is 1 gallon or less, use this container disposal statement. Do not reuse empty container (bottle, can, bucket). Wrap container and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

DANGER: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing spray mist.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, raw egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposing of wastes.
