DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use 2 ounces of **SANISOL** per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Apply **SANISOL** to walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and toilets with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL: At 2 oz. per gallon **SANISOL** will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odor caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces. Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or plain solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

DANGER
