The amendment (label update and revised CSF) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Based on the CSF, the following statement must be added:

Physical or Chemical Hazards
Do not use or store near heat or open flame

b. Delete the phrase: "and aquatic organisms".

c. Revise the heading: "Net" to read: Net Contents"

d. Add the following additional precautionary statement:

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

e. Delete the statement: Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

6. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (dated December 16, 1993) is acceptable. Note also that this confidential will supersede all previous confidentials.

However note for future reference that the upper certified limit (Block 14a) should be around 51.5% and the lower certified limit (Block 14b) should be around 48.5% for this product. Also Block #13b should read: 100%.

CORROSIVE

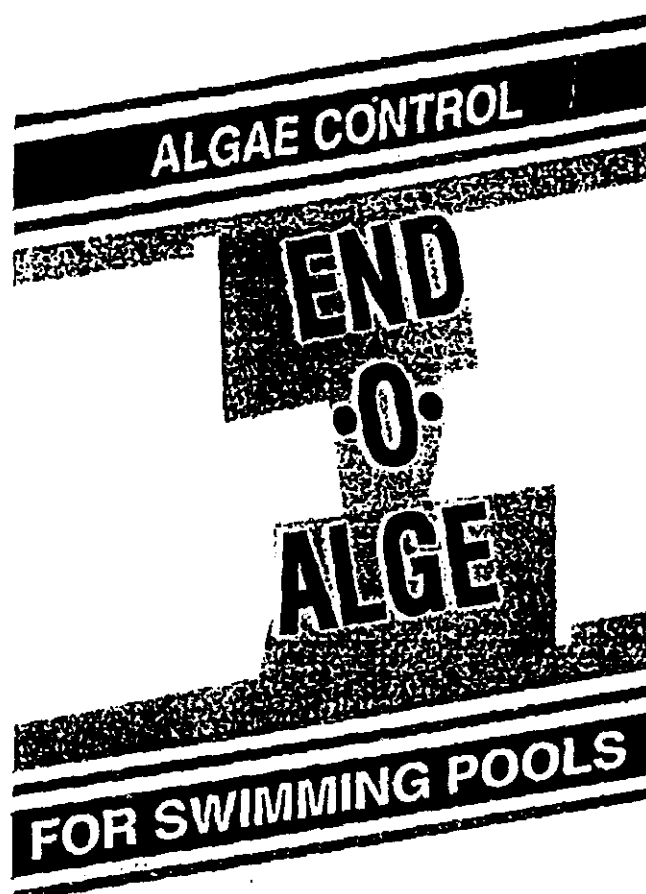

This product provides protection against algae growth for months in a 10,000 gallon pool.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

1. Upon filling pool add 10,000 gallons of water.
2. Follow this by adding 10,000 gallons every 10,000 gallons of water.
3. When algae growth is present per 10,000 gallons of water when algae is dead, D. sary and refill. Repeat 6 ozs. per 10,000 gallons. Container provides protection for 52,000 gallons of water.
4. Use other chemicals as directed on individual package.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. Storage Instruction: Store in original containers and place in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Contaminate water, for storage or disposal.
2. Spill or Leak Procedure: Be mopped up or flush with water or absorbed on material and incinerated.
3. Pesticide Disposal: Store in original container in sealed newspaper and discard.
4. Container Disposal: Empty container (bottle, can) thoroughly before discard.
5. General: Consult Federal disposal authorities for native procedures such as burning.
