The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete "General Classification."
 - b. Revise the front panel referral statement to read "See practical treatment and additional precautions on side panel."
 - c. Move the Practical Treatment paragraph above the Environmental Hazards so that they are immediately below the human precautionary statements.
 - d. Under Maintenance Program, include instructions to test and maintain the water pH to between 7.2 to 7.6.
 - e. Include the company's street address on the label.
2. Submit the final printed label for inclusion in the product file.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention immediately. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If inhaled, remove person to fresh air.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and place in trash.
