POOL START

When filling your new pool or refilling with fresh water at:
1. Bring pool water pH to a range reading between 7.2 and 7.6.
2. Chlorinate and stabilize pool water by adding Sears Pool Stabilizer.
Alternate procedure: add SEARS di-chlorine Granular Concentrate to drop to 3 to 5 ppm before entering pool.
3. Start tablet feeding program.

TABLET FEEDING PROGRAM

The number of tablets required for your pool may vary due to pool size, water temperature, or skimmer.

To start your tablet feeding program put 16 tablets in your skimmer DAILY and add tablets as required to maintain an available chlorine level of 1.0 ppm. FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION SUPER CHLORINATE YOUR POOL ONCE A WEEK.

Keep away from water. Rinse container thoroughly clean with water before reuse.

Internal—feed cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk, for 24 hours.
External—in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with water for 15 minutes.

CONVENIENT AND EFFECTIVE BACTERIA AND ALGAE CONTROL

Slow dissolving, completely soluble Sears Tri-Chlorine Concentrate Tablets take the work out of pool care by providing a continuous and economical system of chlorine disinfection. For effective bacteria and algae control maintain an available chlorine level of 3.0 to 5.0 ppm as determined by SEARS chlorine test kit 42 4227.

POOL START-UP (PRE-CONDITIONING) INSTRUCTIONS

When filling your new pool or refilling with fresh water at any time:

1. Bring pool water pH to a range reading between 7.2 and 7.6 on your Sears Test Kit 42 4227 and add SEARS Water Conditioner 42 4273.
2. Chlorinate and stabilize pool water by adding Sears Pool Shock 42 4282 as prescribed on label.

Alternate procedure: add SEARS di-chlorine Granular Concentrate 42 4275 at a rate of 8 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water. Allow the available chlorine residual to drop to 3 to 5 ppm before entering pool.

3. Start tablet feeding program.

TABLET FEEDING PROGRAM FOR PROPERLY PRE-CONDITIONED POOLS

The number of tablets required for your pool may vary depending on temperature, wind, rain, pool usage and feeding method; float, submersible cage or skimmer.

To start your tablet feeding program put 16 tablets in your feeder for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. TEST YOUR POOL FOR CHLORINE LEVEL DAILY and add tablets as required to maintain an available chlorine level of 3 to 5 ppm.

FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION SUPER CHLORINATE YOUR POOL WITH SEARS POOL SHOCK 42 4282 EVERY TWO WEEKS AS PRESCRIBED ON THE LABEL.

DANGER

CORROSIVE

Causes eye damage. May cause burns on broken skin. Dust irritating to nose and throat. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes when handling. Avoid breathing dust.

STRONG OXIDIZING MATERIAL. Contact with organic matter or any foreign material may result in fire or explosive decomposition. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Use only dry, clean measures. Mix only with water. Rinse container thoroughly clean with water before discarding.

FIRST AID

Internal—feed cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil.

External—in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes.
