SEARS CONCENTRATE 1-inch Tablets

Use only with Sears Refillable Floating Chlorinator CONVENIENT AND EFFECTIVE BACTERIA AND ALGAE CONTROL

Slow dissolving, completely soluble Sears Tri-Chlor Concentrate Tablets takes the work out of pool care by providing a continuous and economical system of chlorine disinfection. For effective bacteria and algae control maintain an available chlorine level of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm as determined by Sears Chlorine Test Kit.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

POOL START UP (CONDITIONING) INSTRUCTIONS

When first filling your new pool or refilling with fresh water at any time.

1. Superchlorinate (shock treat) pool with Sears D. Chlor Granular Concentrate as prescribed below, to burn out harmful bacteria.
2. Test pool water with Sears Test Kit and bring pH into 7.2-7.6 range. Add Sears Dry Acid to reduce pH or Soda Ash to increase pH as prescribed on labels.
3. Add Sears Water Conditioner as prescribed on label to protect chlorine against loss due to sunlight.

MAINTENANCE FEEDING PROGRAM FOR PROPERLY PRE-CONDITIONED POOLS

The number of tablets required for your pool will vary depending on temperature, wind, rain, pool usage and feeding method. Float feeder or skimmer.

To start your tablet feeding program put 10 Sears 1/2 oz. tablets in your feeder for every 10,000 gallons of pool water. TEST YOUR POOL FOR CHLORINE LEVEL DAILY. Add tablets as required to maintain an available chlorine level of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm. Do not throw tablets directly into pool—spitting will occur.

Maintain pH reading in a range from 7.2 to 7.6 on your test kit. Add Sears Dry Acid or Soda Ash as prescribed on labels to reduce or increase pH.

PERIODIC SUPER CHLORINATION

Heavy swimmer loads, wind, dust and rainfall can cause bacteria and microscopic debris to accumulate in pool water. To maintain clean, clear water, superchlorinate with Sears Di-Chlor Granular Concentrate, as prescribed on label, every two weeks, weekly during hot weather.
