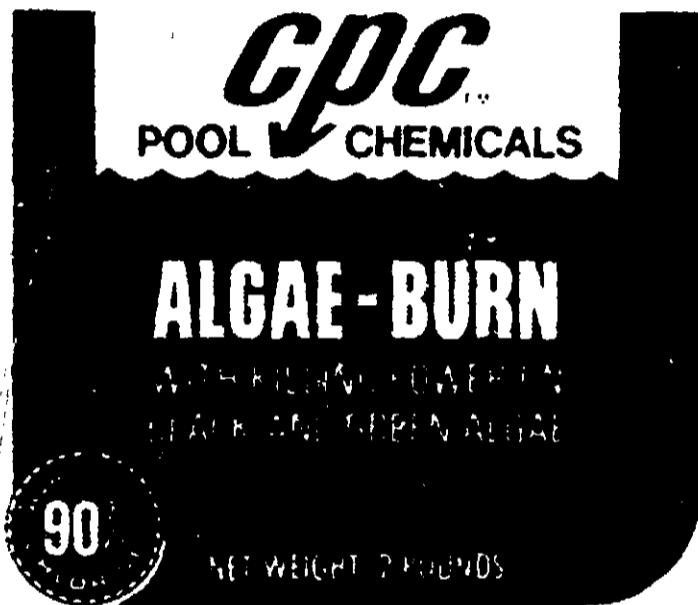

CPC ALGAE-BURN

ALGAE-BURN is an extremely concentrated algaecide with killing power on black and green algae.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Turn off filter pump
2. Brush black algae spots with stainless steel brush
3. Sprinkle Algae-burn directly over pool walls and floor where algae appears. Use approximately 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of pool water. For severe cases double the dosage.
4. Brush affected areas again after Algae-burn has dissolved.
5. Filter pump may be turned on two hours after treatment.

DO NOT RE-ENTER POOL UNTIL CHLORINE RESIDUAL DROPS TO 1.5 P.P.M. AS INDICATED ON APPROPRIATE TEST KIT.

DO NOT USE ALGAE-BURN IN POOLS WITH VINYL LINERS. APPLY THIS PRODUCT ONLY AS SPECIFIED ON THIS LABEL. THIS PRODUCT IS TOXIC TO FISH. TREATED EFFLUENT SHOULD NOT BE DISCHARGED WHERE IT WILL DRAIN INTO LAKES, STREAMS, PONDS, OR PUBLIC WATER.

DANGER

CORROSIVE—Causes eye damage. May cause burns on broken skin. Irritating to nose and throat if inhaled. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes when handling. Avoid breathing dust.
STRONG OXIDIZING MATERIAL. Contact with organic matter or any foreign material may result in fire or explosive decomposition. Moisture contamination or fire may liberate irritating and hazardous chlorine containing gases. Avoid contamination with combustible materials. Keep away from heat and moisture. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Use only dry, clean measure. Mix only with water. Rinse container thoroughly clean with water before discarding.
FIRST AID—Internal—Feed cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil. External—in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes.

CPC ALGAE-BURN

ALGAE-BURN is an extremely concentrated algaecide with great power on black and green algae.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Turn off filter pump
2. Brush black algae spots with stainless steel brush
3. Sprinkle Algae-burn directly over pool walls and floor where algae appears. Use approximately 1 pound per 10.0 gallons of water. For severe cases double the dosage.
4. Brush affected areas again after Algae-burn has been applied.
5. Filter pump may be turned on two hours after treatment.

DANGER
