

whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae to 4 fluid ounces of Algae Stop - 30 per 1000 gallons of water. In a cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initial dose of Algae Stop - 30 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Algae Stop - 30 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Algae Stop - 30 is compatible with those chemicals used in spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Algae Stop - 30 should be used in conjunction with chlorine products. Algae Stop - 30 is not required. However, do not mix Algae Stop - 30 with chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed. Do not allow to contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or use. Rinse that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of. Do not use for pesticides or buried in a safe place or dumping is prohibited.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water.

2. Regular Maintenance

Add 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days.

3. Trouble Shooting

For green algae:

- a. Super chlorinate pool.
- b. Add 24 to 36 fluid ounces of Algae Stop-30 per 10,000 gallons of pool water.
- c. Vacuum settled algae debris to waste.
- d. Follow regular maintenance above.

For black algae:

- a. Scrub surface of algae with stiff brush.
- b. Super chlorinate pool.
- c. Add 24 to 36 fluid ounces of Algae Stop-30 per 10,000 gallons of pool water.
- d. Vacuum settled algae debris to waste.
- e. Follow regular maintenance above.

For yellow algae:

- a. Scrub loose clinging algae from pool walls.
- b. Vacuum algae debris from pool bottom to waste.
- c. Super chlorinate pool.
- d. Add 24 to 36 fluid ounces of Algae Stop-30 per 10,000 gallons of pool water.
- e. Repeat (b) above.
- f. Follow regular maintenance above.
