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Fast dissolving, completely soluble FASTAB stabilized tablets *6284-13* provide a convenient pre-measured dosage. Eliminate possible spillage and measuring spoons associated with the use of granular chlorinating compounds.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN SWIMMING POOLS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not throw FASTAB tablets directly into pool - spotting will occur. FASTAB tablets are to be added to the pool skimmer or into a floating dispenser.

START UP

1. Super chlorinate (shock treat) water by adding 1 FASTAB stabilized tablet per 1,000 gallons of pool water. Use tablet dispenser or skimmer to dissolve tablets (see above). Let chlorine level drop to 1 to 2 PPM range *before entering the pool.*
2. Test pool water pH and adjust to the 7.2 to 7.6 range using dry acid or soda ash as required.
3. Add water conditioner* (stabilizer) as prescribed on label to give permanent protection of chlorine against loss due to sun light.

*New water only--not needed in water previously treated.

DAILY

1. Add 1 FASTAB stabilized tablet per 2,000 gallons of pool water. Test to determine chlorine level. If below 1 PPM, add enough tablets to bring it to 1 to 2 PPM range.
2. Test pH of pool water. Maintain pH in 7.2 to 7.6 PPM range by adding soda ash or dry acid as required.

FOR PERIOD SUPER CHLORINATION

Heavy swimmer loads, wind, dust and rainfall can cause bacteria and microscopic debris to accumulate in pool water. To maintain clean, clear water, super chlorinate every two weeks, weekly during hot weather.

1. Add 1 FASTAB stabilized tablet to dispenser or skimmer per 1,000 gallons of water to bring chlorine level up to the 5 to 10 PPM range.
2. Wait until chlorine level has dropped to 3 PPM before entering pool.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Use empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before disposal. For more information, contact your distributor or call 1-800-4-A-POOL.
