 - iii. Change the container disposal statement to read "Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash."
 - iv. At the end of Storage and Disposal, add "For minor spills, leaks, etc., follow all precautions indicated on this label and clean up immediately. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during cleanup procedures and disposal of wastes."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. If swallowed, if victim is fully conscious, immediately give 1 or 2 glasses of water to drink and induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Apply artificial respiration if necessary. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate domestic, livestock or irrigation water supplies, or lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state or local procedures. Completely empty container by shaking, and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into skimmer. Then triple rinse and dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product effectively prevents and control the growth of algae in swimming pools. There is no waiting to swim. The effectiveness of this product is not influenced by the normal range of swimming pool water pH.

This product is compatible with all pool additives, is non-foaming, will not stain, and is non-corrosive to pool filters, heaters, piping and the fittings. Pool filtering systems will not reduce the effectiveness of this product. The use of this product will not replace the need for chlorine to maintain proper pH and sanitation, but does relieve the need for excessive quantities of chlorine to combat algae.

Mix the correct dosage as specified below in a container of clear water, shake or agitate thoroughly, and evenly distribute the mixture over the water to be treated.

Never pour water into chemicals. Always mix chemical into water.

Pour the mixture into the skimmer or evenly distribute around the edge of the pool. Water temperature of 80°F or greater results in faster algae control.

GREEN ALGAE CONTROL

Apply 1.6 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water when algae growth is first visible. Seven days later, brush algae from walls and vacuum out settled algae. Repeat when algae reappears.

BLACK ALGAE CONTROL

Apply 2.4 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of water when algae growth is first visible. For faster results, remove top of algae growth with a pool brush daily and vacuum out settled algae. Repeat when algae reappear.

NOTE: Do not use treated water on plants or lawns as this product and other pool chemicals could cause damage.
