GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Begin treatment when insects are first noticed. Repeat applications as often as necessary. For optimum dust characteristics, invert closed container once just before using. Hold container at a slight angle (up or down) from the horizontal and squeeze. Avoid a straight downward position. Thorough coverage of both sides of the leaves is necessary for good control. For best results apply in early morning when dew is on plants or after watering. Do not harvest vegetables less than two days after last application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL DIRECTIONS

STORAGE: STORE UNDER COOL, DRY CONDITIONS: Storage periods of one year are not considered detrimental to the effectiveness of this product.
