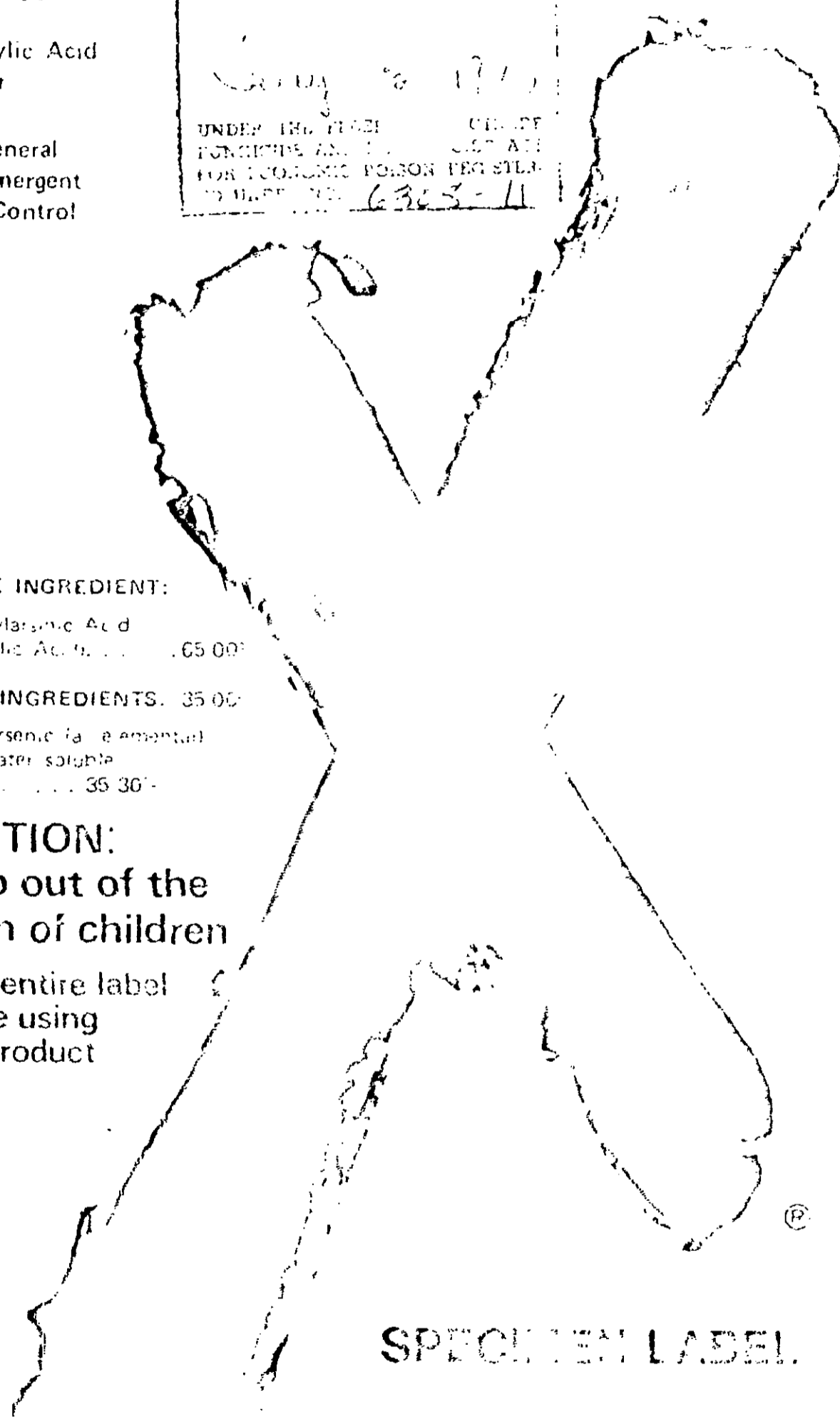

GENERAL INFORMATION: PHYTAR 138 Herbicide is useful for general post-emergent weed control. It is non-selective in its action. Its phytotoxic property is not quickly inactivated in contact with the soil. Its effectiveness is markedly increased by addition of surfactant to the spray solution. Best results are obtained on young actively growing weeds. It produces top kill only. Multiple applications are required for season-long weed control of perennials.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: PHYTAR 138 Herbicide is completely water soluble. Fill the spray equipment tank about half full with water and add the required amount of herbicide and surfactant with agitation. Fresh filling the tank with water and apply. After use, clean equipment thoroughly by flushing with water. Do not store spray solution in tank for a prolonged period. Although PHYTAR 138 Herbicide is only moderately corrosive, do not use in galvanized or aluminum equipment.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Destroy by burying in a safe place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
NON-CROP: PHYTAR 138 Herbicide is useful for general (weed) control on drainage ditches, banks or rights-of-way, along sidewalks, driveways and fences, around buildings and ornamentals, and in similar non-crop areas. Mix 4 to 8 pounds of PHYTAR 138 Herbicide and 4 pints of a surfactant in 100 gallons of water. Spray unwanted vegetation thoroughly to just short of run-off. Any spray equipment that gives good coverage may be used. If regrowth occurs, reapply as required.

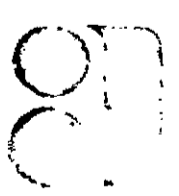
Do not apply directly, or allow spray to come in contact with foliage, green bark, grafted unions, or scuffed, damaged or broken bark when spraying around trees and ornamentals. Do not contaminate waters used for domestic consumption, or by animals, wildlife and aquatic life, or for irrigation purposes. Do not graze treated areas to livestock.

LAWN RENOVATION: Mow lawn to be renovated about 1 inch high before treatment. Mix 2 ounces of PHYTAR 138 Herbicide and 2 fluid ounces of a surfactant in 4 gallons of water and apply to 1,000 sq. ft. Cover foliage thoroughly, preferably on a warm sunny day. Foliage will usually be brown in about five days. Bermudagrass and other deep-rooted perennials, or uncovered foliage that require a second treatment. Reapply five days later if green areas remain.

When foliage is all brown, matted areas should be raked and debris removed. About 10 days after last treatment, water thoroughly and then seed at rate recommended for new lawn. Soil must be raked into soil. Keep seeded areas well watered. Keep children and pets off treated areas until after first rain or sprinkling following treatment. Do not track from treated to untreated areas.
