**GENERAL INFORMATION:** ANSAR 184 Herbicide is useful for selective post emergent weed control, particularly for grassy weeds. Its activity is enhanced by addition of a suitable surfactant to the spray solution. It is most effective on young, actively growing weeds at a temperature above 70°F. Its phytotoxic properties are quickly inactivated on contact with the soil.

**MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:** ANSAR 184 Herbicide must be thoroughly dissolved. Fill the spray equipment reservoir about half full with water and add the required amount of herbicide with agitation. Finish filling the reservoir with water and apply. Do not store spray solution in tank for a prolonged period, and clean application equipment thoroughly after using by flushing with water.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**COTTON:** ANSAR 184 Herbicide is useful as a directed spray application in cotton for post emergent control of weeds and grasses including johnsongrass, nutsedge, dallisgrass, cocklebur, ragweed, sandbur and puncture vine. ANSAR 184 Herbicide should be applied to weeds in cotton at the rate of 3.6 pounds per acre.

Mix at the rate of 9.0 pounds in 100 gallons of water and add 1 to 2 quarts of a mild surfactant. Apply at a broadcast rate of 40 gallons per acre. Best results are obtained at temperatures above 70°F. For band application, apply at the rate of 1 gallon of this solution for each inch of band width per acre for cotton in 40 inch rows. A second application may be required during humid growing conditions. Time the second application, if necessary, about 1 to 3 weeks after the first application.

**APPLY ONLY WHEN COTTON IS 3 INCHES HIGH TO FIRST BLOOM. DO NOT APPLY AFTER FIRST BLOOM. DO NOT FEED TREATED FOLIAGE TO LIVESTOCK, OR GRAZE TREATED AREAS.**

Spot burning and a reddish discoloration of the cotton leaf may occasionally occur following the recommended treatment, but the cotton plant will develop normally. ANSAR 184 Herbicide should be applied with a low volume sprayer, having satisfactory pumping and bypass action. Nozzles should be placed so as to avoid spraying the cotton foliage but also to give good coverage of the weeds and grasses. Proper coverage is very important. Adjust nozzles to allow maximum coverage of weeds and grasses. Adjust nozzles to direct the spray in a manner to allow maximum coverage of weeds. Keep spray off cotton foliage.

**NON CROP:** ANSAR 184 Herbicide is useful for controlling johnsongrass, nutsedge, and certain other weeds in rights of way, storage yards, and similar non crop areas. Mix ANSAR 184 Herbicide at the rate of 4 to 9 pounds plus 1 to 2 quarts of a suitable surfactant, in 100 gallons of water. Spray the unwanted vegetation thoroughly to just short of runoff. Any spray equipment that gives good coverage may be used. If a spraythru nozzle is used, apply as required.

**DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATERS USED FOR DOMESTIC CONSUMPTION, OR BY ANIMALS, WILDLIFE AND AQUATIC LIFE, OR FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES.**

**LAWN AND ORNAMENTAL TURF:** ANSAR 184 Herbicide is designed for the selective kill of dallisgrass, crabgrass, bahia grass, nutsedge, crabgrass, chickweed, and wood sorrel with little or no injury to good lawn grasses. On new lawns, do not treat until after three mowings. Good grasses may be temporarily affected, especially in hot weather. Rain or watering will revive them. Bent and fescue grasses are generally more sensitive, and may be temporarily discolored. Zoysia, bluegrasses, and bermuda are tolerant. Do not use on St. Augustine or centipede. Mow lawns 1 to 1 1/2 inches high before treatment. Mix two ounces of ANSAR 184 Herbicide in 5 gallons of water, containing 2 to 3 fluid ounces of a suitable surfactant, and apply to an area of 1000 sq. ft. Spray thoroughly to wet all undesirable plants. Repeat applications, 10 to 14 days apart, may be needed for good control.
