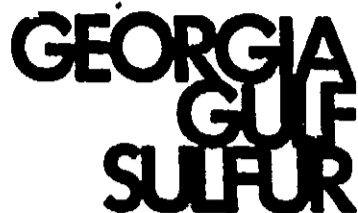

PRODUCT USE RECOMMENDATIONS
MANUFACTURING SULFUR

Manufacturing Sulfur is prepared to be most useful as an ingredient in wettable powder and dusting powder formulations, either of the single ingredient sulfur or in mixtures with other pesticides.

Pre-weigh and stage all ingredients in a clear area adjacent to the batching station. Into an operating double ribbon blender or equivalent mixing apparatus, add ingredients in the following order:

1. Diluent or absorbent
2. Manufacturing Sulfur
3. Other active ingredient
4. Wetting agent or tackifier
5. Anti-caking agent

Continue to blend for a minimum of 15 minutes after the addition of the last ingredient. If one of the ingredients is a liquid, it is advisable to use a double blender arrangement with an attrition mill between the blenders.

Package finished product.

Since dry sulfur can be explosive in heavy dust concentrations, proper precautions should be taken, in accordance with the Material Safety Data Sheet, to provide for an inert gas atmosphere* for all closed mixing, handling, bulk storage, and packaging.
