GENERAL INFORMATION

Yellow Jacket Wettable Sulfur is formulated for use as a dust or spray in water as a spray on fruit, vegetable and ornamental crops for the control of certain fungus diseases and mites. It may be substituted for use with most of the commonly used fungicides and acaricides.

Pour the specific amount of this product into a space of water in nearly filled spray tank or pre-mix in a bucket before pouring into spray tank. Add balance of water to fill tank. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations. Do not allow mixture to stand. Do not use in low volume gear-type spray equipment. Do not combine with emulsifiable liquids unless previous use of the mixture has proven physically compatible and safe to plants.

CAUTION: Do not use sulfur in combination with oil or within 21-60 days of an oil spray. Do not use sulfur on apples or other sensitive crops when shade temperatures exceed, or are likely to exceed, 90° F. Do not apply or allow sulfur to drift to Cucurbit (Cucumber, cantaloupe, melon, squash) or tung. To do so may result in severe and leaf injury. When growing crops for processing, consult the processor applying sulfur.
