Your February 12, 2001 application for supplemental labeling

Dear Ms. Webb,

The application above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable regarding the submitted supplemental labeling addressing drift. However, revisions are required in the master label as follows:

1. Statements of Practical Treatment have been updated per Pesticide Registration (PR) Notice 2001-1. Revise the statements as follows:

A. Place the various elements into a boxed format as indicated in the PR Notice and replace the current heading with "First Aid" rather than Statements of Practical Treatment.

B. The "If in eyes:" statement must read:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

C. The "If on skin" statement must read:

"If on skin or clothing:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

D. The "If swallowed" statement is not required (since the product is in acute toxicity category

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IV) and may be deleted. However, if the "If swallowed" statement is voluntarily retained it must read:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

E. The "If inhaled:" statement must read:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."

F. Include this general statement with the first aid statements at the beginning or end: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."

G. It is recommended that an emergency phone number be included at the end of the above sentence, (F). If a number is included, also include a phrase or statement indicating the kinds of information available at the number and any limitation such as hours of service.

2. Delete the statement "Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs" from the precautionary statements since it is repeated more appropriately in the "Storage and Disposal" section.

3. The sulfur RED indicates you must add "protective eyewear" to the PPE in the "Agriculture Use Requirements" box and to the PPE for "Applicators and other handlers" and for "Mixers and loaders".

4. In the precautionary statements box under PPE, add the following statement "Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are listed below. If you want more options, follow the instructions for category A on an EPA chemical-resistance category selection chart." In the statements for applicators and other handlers and in the statements for mixers and loaders, replace "waterproof gloves" with "chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material such as polyethylene or polyvinyl chloride".

5. In the agricultural use requirements box, replace "waterproof gloves" with "chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material".

6. In the use recommendations for grapes, revise the sentence to read "Rust, Powdery Mildew - apply ... and every 10 to 14 days thereafter to harvest."

Make the revisions indicated above in the master label and submit five copies of the revised label. A stamped accepted copy of the supplemental label is enclosed for your files. If there are questions concerning this matter, contact Dr. Tom Ellwanger at (703) 308-9352.

SUPPLEMENTAL LABELING

YELLOW JACKET SPECIAL DUSTING SULFUR
EPA REG. NO. 6325-17

FOR ALL CROP USES LISTED ON THE PRODUCT LABEL
(for both ground and air applications)

Dusting sulfur can create situations where drift to non-target of sensitive areas can occur. To minimize the occurrence of drift incidents, the following conditions must be met:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (GENERAL)

In addition to specific instructions under directions for use on the main sulfur label, the following conditions must also be followed for use in California.

1. The operator of the property and the applicator must establish a buffer zone of enough distance to prevent drift onto non-target areas such as hospitals, clinics, residential areas, schools, and any other area designated by the county agricultural commissioner.
2. The operator of the property and the applicator must evaluate the method and equipment for each site to ensure proper and safe use. Evaluations shall include, but not be limited to the appropriateness of ground or air application.
3. Sulfur shall not be applied when the wind velocity exceeds 10 miles per hour. Applicators should be aware that in some areas of California, "dead calm" conditions are often associated with an inversion situation. In these areas, applying sulfur when there is a minimum air movement of 2 miles per hour will help ensure that an inversion situation does not exist.
4. All applicators, prior to use of dust formulations, should read and understand the Best Application Practices Manual.
5. Before using this product, read and follow all applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label.
