

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To sanitize ice storage bins, scoops, refrigerators, milk dispensers, vending machines, ice cream machines, or other hard surfaces, remove all foods and ice from equipment to be sanitized. Wash all surfaces thoroughly with a good detergent such as Vapco A.P.C. and rinse. Prepare a solution of 1 ounce Vapco Sanitizer in 2 gallons of water. Apply with a Vapco Trigger Sprayer, cloth, or brush. Surfaces should remain wet for at least 1 minute. **NO POTABLE WATER RINSE REQUIRED.**

To sanitize ice machine production mechanism, shut off machine and drain water reservoir. Refill with a solution of 1 ounce Vapco Sanitizer in 2 gallons of water. Start circulating pump only and run 10 minutes. Drain and flush all solution from the system. Refill with fresh water and start ice production. Discard first ice harvest.
