When used as directed, the hard surface disinfecting action of **CLEAN-A-CIDE** will reduce the hazard of cross contamination. When used as directed **CLEAN-A-CIDE** will deodorize toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause malodors.

Disinfection — To disinfect water, treated surface **CLEAN-A-CIDE** is a disinfectant.

Sanitizing — To sanitize, use 1 oz. per gallon of water.

3 oz. per gallon use evaluated in the presence of the following organisms:

Escherichia coli
Salmonella cholerae
Staphylococcus aureus

AOAC Fungicidal — **CLEAN-A-CIDE** is a fungicide (kills foot fungus) when used in bath areas, exercise areas, etc.

Virucidal Performance — At 3 oz. per gallon, 10% serum and 10% Simplex (a metformin derivative) in water.

Vaccinia (representative virus) on human, monkey, and dog cells.

Sanitizing-Non Fungicidal — At 1 oz. per gallon, five sanitizing agents: *C. aureus* and *K. pneumoniae* on non porous surfaces.

As 3 oz. per gallon, mildew.

Directions for Use GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

For use in accordance with Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

CLEAN-A-CIDE is a heavy-duty step cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-fungicide-virucide in the presence of 10% detergent and 10% organic soil.

Apply **CLEAN-A-CIDE** to walls, floors, and other hard non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a brush, mop, mechanical spray device, or as thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection — To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces, add 3 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use level, **CLEAN-A-CIDE** is also virucidal and fungicidal.

Sanitizing — To sanitize porous or non-porous non-food contact surfaces, add 1 oz. per gallon of water.

3 oz. per gallon use-level. The broad spectrum of **CLEAN-A-CIDE** has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following organisms by the AOAC Use Dilution test:

Escherichia coli
Salmonella choleraesuis
Staphylococcus aureus

AOAC Fungicidal Test

CLEAN-A-CIDE is effective against *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise areas, dressing rooms, etc.

Virucidal Performance

At 3 oz. per gallon use-level, **CLEAN-A-CIDE** has been evaluated in the presence of 10% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis), Vaccinia (representative of the pox viruses), and Influenza A (the Hong Kong flu virus) on inanimate environmental surfaces.

Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces, such as floors, walls, tables, etc., etc.: At 1 oz. per gallon use-level, 2 minutes of contact time **CLEAN-A-CIDE** is an effective sanitizing agent on walls (up to 400 ppm hardness) against *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Klebsiella pneumoniae* in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.

At 2 oz. per gallon, **CLEAN-A-CIDE** will control odors caused by mold and mildew.
