DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Flush toilet. Add 3 fluid oz. (6 tablespoons) directly to water in toilet bowl (3-4 gallon). Brush to cover all interior surfaces of the bowl including under the rim. Allow disinfectant solution to remain at least 10 minutes. Flush toilet.

For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning may be required.

To clean badly stained bowls, repeat above treatment using 5 to 6 fluid ounces of **TOILET BOWL & PORCELAIN CLEANER**.

For use in urinals, add 3 fluid oz. (6 tablespoons) to 1/4 gallon of water. Apply by brush to all urinal surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Flush.
