

DISINFECTING: To disinfect only, generally use about 1 ounce of Sani-Det per gallon of warm or hot water. Higher temperatures usually expedite germicidal action. This cleaner is effective against gram positive type bacteria (e.g. Use dilution AOAC vs. S. aureus 1:128); against gram negative bacteria (e.g. S. typhosa) a phenol coef. (AOAC) of 5.5.

GENERAL CLEANING and DISINFECTING: When soil removal as well as disinfection of a surface is required, heavier concentration of the cleaner is recommended. A clean surface is very important in maintaining sanitary conditions. Generally 6 ounces of cleaner in a gallon of warm water for furniture, venetian blinds, painted woodwork, walls, leather and plastics, upholstery, tile, marble, baked enamel and varnished surfaces, glassware, lockers, etc.

FLOORS

General Scrubbing: Dilute 4 ounces of cleaner in gallon of warm water. Apply solution over area. Pick up and rinse with clear, clean water.

Wax Stripping: Dilute 10 to 20 ounces of cleaner in a gallon of hot water. Spread over area and scrub with stiff brush or scrubbing pad and scrubbing machine. Pick up and rinse with clear water.

Damp Mopping: Dilute 2 ounces of cleaner in a gallon of water. Apply with mop after wringing out excess of solution.

CAUTION: Concentrate will cause irritation to skin and eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with concentrate; dilute before using. Use rubber gloves. In case of contact, rinse thoroughly with water. For eyes, wash thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, call physician.

Avoid contamination of feed and food stufs. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. DO NOT TAKE INTERNALLY.
