DIRECTIONS

Moderately soiled surfaces should be thoroughly wet down with water. Sprinkle Kitchen Kienzer liberally over the entire surface. Work up a foam and allow to stand at least 10 minutes. Kitchen Kienzer should then be removed by rinsing the surface thoroughly and wiping repeatedly with a clean sponge or mop. Repeat if necessary.

Floors: Wet floors and sprinkle with Kitchen Kienzer, allow to stand for 10 minutes. Scrub with hand brush or floor machine. Steel wool or nylon pads may be used if preferred. Rinse thoroughly and let dry.

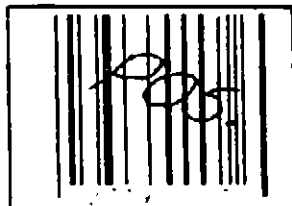
