Kitchen Klezzer should then be removed by rinsing the surface thoroughly and wiping liberally with a cloth, sponge or mop. Repeat if necessary.

FLOORS: Wet floors and scrub with Kitchen Klezzer, allow to stand for 10 minutes. Scrub with hand brush or floor machine. Steel wool or nylon pads may be used if preferred. Rinse thoroughly and dry.

NOTE: On delicate surfaces, use a soft, unclean rag and add copious amount of water, rub gently and rinse. If you are cleaning painted or varnished surfaces, use a small area test. Do not use on silver, chrome, surfaces, wax, soft plastic, aluminum or rubber items (suzuki tires). 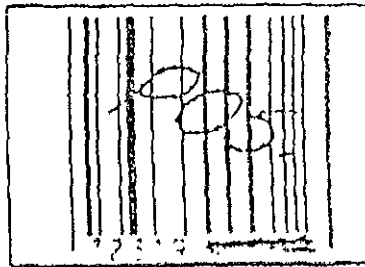
