Dear Mr. Kretsch:

This is in response to your change in label use directions.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, in the sentence, "If product is swallowed...", delete the reference to milk, egg whites, and gelatin solution so that the sentence reads, "If product is swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water."

2. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" immediately below the signal word "Danger".

3. Add a net contents statement to the label.

DANGER

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid contamination of food. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply in marine and/or estuarine oil fields. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in cool dry area. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
