- 1. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, in the sentence, "If product is swallowed...," delete the reference to milk, egg whites, and gelatin solution so that the sentence reads, "If product is swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water."
- 2. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" immediately below the signal word "Danger".
 - 3. Add a net contents statement to the label.
