READ DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY:

1. To kill FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOS and WASPS, close doors and windows, directing the spray up toward ceiling. The room should be filled with mist and remain closed for 10 minutes. Sweep up dead or stupified insects and destroy them. Repeat treatment as often as necessary. Spray frequently breeding places such as stagnant water and manure piles.
2. To kill CRICKETS, ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS and WATER BUGS spray with force around sinks, refrigerators, all cabinets, around pantry shelves, into all cracks and crevices in moulding and woodwork, pipe openings in walls and floors, or wherever these insects are likely to hide. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.
3. To kill ANTS spray all cracks and crevices thoroughly in all infested areas. Repeat process, if quantity sprayed was insufficient to meet desired effect. Remember to spray ant trails, areas around door sills and window frames where the pests enter the premises. Repeat periodically.

CAUTION:

Contains combustible material. Do not spray on or near open flames. Store in a cool place. Keep container tightly closed. IF SWALLOWED GET MEDICAL ATTENTION. Remove or cover exposed food before spraying. Remove pets, birds and cover fish bowls before spraying. KNOCK-OUT could discolor and soften asphalt tile and some linoleum, if sprayed closely to the surface. Do not use excessive amount.

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4. To kill BED BUGS, mattresses and springs should be sprayed thoroughly after the bed has been dismantled, paying particular attention to cracks, crevices, tufts and seams on mattresses, wall paper that is loose, loose moulding and any place where these bugs may hide. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.
5. To kill CARPET BEETLES, FLEAS, LICE and CLOTHING MOTHS take special precautions to see that cracks in floors and openings below baseboards are thoroughly wetted with spray liquid. Wool lint and organic matter accumulating in these places serve as breeding locations for such pests. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned and aired and sprayed carefully from a distance of one to two feet, taking care to see that seams and folds are wetted. Chests in which woolens are to be stored should be thoroughly sprayed before being filled with clothes. Closets should be sprayed liberally at least twice a month, directing the spray on the garments. Be sure, that the spraying liquid covers thoroughly all the surfaces and objects to be protected. As far as FLEAS are concerned remove animal's bedding and spray freely all the floors, floor coverings, walls, baseboards and sleeping quarters of animals; force your spray into cracks. Repeat the treatment as often as necessary.
