PURATIZED SC

SLIME CONTROL IN PAPER MILLS

PURATIZED SC is a new compound offered to the paper trade for the control of slimes. This material is a phenyl mercuric lactate type formula. It is sold in the form of white flakes or powder, packaged in non-sifting 1 oz. envelopes. Information regarding the properties of PURATIZED SC is listed overleaf.

Close scrutiny of all available literature on the subject of slime control shows that authorities are in agreement on one specific point--the most effective bactericides from the standpoint of cost and killing power are the mercurials. Like all products of this type, PURATIZED SC is highly toxic to human beings. It is for this reason that a non-sifting envelope was selected which defibers easily under normal mill conditions. We recommend that the operators be very careful if, for any reason, they wish to open the envelopes and dissolve the contents in water. When any mercurial comes in contact with the skin, the affected part should be washed immediately with large quantities of soap and water.

In one plant where our product was successfully employed, the following procedure was used:

1. Add PURATIZED SC to the beater at the rate of 1 oz. per ton of stock for approximately one week.
2. Gradually reduce the amount of PURATIZED SC to 1 oz. per 5 tons of stock or until the optimum quantity for satisfactory slime control is determined.

As slime conditions vary appreciably from mill to mill, we recommend that our representative be consulted concerning methods of application and quantities required.
