

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Read and follow all Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use PLEXIDYNE in Hospitals, Health Care Facilities and Food processing plants for sanitizing of non-porous tableware, cutlery, food processing equipment, for glassware, and other non-porous materials.

PLEXIDYNE is a concentrated sanitizing and disinfecting agent, and must be properly diluted before using. **2 MAKE WELL BEFORE USE.**

Sanitizing of tableware, cutlery, etc. in a three sink hand dishwashing operation.

1. Scrub and/or prewash all items to be cleaned.
2. Wash items with suitable detergent solution in first sink.
3. Rinse items with clear water in second sink.
4. Sanitize items by immersing them in solution consisting of 1 oz. PLEXIDYNE for each 10 gallons of water (25 ppm available iodine) for at least 2 minutes.
5. Air dry.

Sanitizing barware in automatic dishwashing machines

1. Pre-rinse, pre-rinse and load machines.
2. Wash. Follow machine manufacturers instructions to dispense PLEXIDYNE into final rinse water to provide 25 ppm available iodine (1 oz. PLEXIDYNE per 5 gallons of water.)
3. Air Dry.

Sanitizing of equipment and utensils

1. Scrub or spray all gross food particles from items to be sanitized.
2. Wash item with suitable detergent.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Apply solution of 1 oz. PLEXIDYNE to 5 gallons of water (25 ppm available iodine) by immersion of item or exposing item for 2 minutes.
5. Air dry.

General Disinfecting

1. Pre-clean gross filth and heavy soil from non-porous floors, walls, etc.
2. Wash using a suitable detergent or a solution of 1 oz. of PLEXIDYNE to 5 gallons of water.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Wet surfaces to be sanitized with a solution of 2 oz. PLEXIDYNE to 5 gallons water (50 ppm available iodine), using a mop or an applicator.
