DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING

- 1. MILKERS**
Use a clean paper towel for each cow, wet with a solution of 1 oz I-O-DINE SANITIZER to 5 Gallons of warm water (90 F) (provides 25 PPM available Iodine)
- 2. FARM STORAGE TANKS**
If a log (code permitting) the tank with a solution of 1 oz I-O-DINE SANITIZER to 5 Gallons of warm (90 F) water. Let time mix for at least 5 minutes.
- 3. MILKING EQUIPMENT & UTENSILS**
Use 1 oz to each 5 Gallons of warm water in a tank. Immerse utensils and milking machine parts in solution for at least 5 minutes. Do not immerse pulsators in solution.
