## DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF LIFE-O-FABRIC CHEMICAL

May be used to treat any natural fiber and fabric made with natural fiber, such as Carpets, Rugs, Blankets, Clothing, Draperies, Furniture, etc.

Use sprayer large enough to produce a spray at least one foot in diameter. An electric sprayer with glass container to hold fluid is recommended. Be sure to spray thoroughly so as to moisten every square inch of material being treated.

Life-O-Fabric Chemical, Usable, is ready to use and should not be diluted. Life-O-Fabric, Concentrate, must be diluted before use at rate of one part Concentrate and nineteen parts water.

**Blankets & Comforts:** Hang on line. Spray both sides. Allow sufficient time to dry before storing. Ordinary size blanket requires one quart.

**Clothing:** May be held but best to hang on line or spread on table to give free access in treating. Spray thoroughly with fine mist. Turn collar up, spray inside garment first. **SPRAY THOROUGHLY BOTH SEAMS AND FOLDS.** Keep spray off lining. Place on line or hanger and spray top side. Do not crowd until dry — will not affect crease in pressed clothing. Spray each article separately. 10 to 14 woolen suits or coats can be treated with 1 gallon.

**Carpets & Rugs:** Most carpets require treating on top side only; with exceptions, when the nap or pile of the carpet extends through the warp or base of carpet, then treat both sides. Spray evenly and completely moisten. Spray heavier 12 to 18 inches out around all walls.

**Chinese & Oriental Rugs:** Require treating on both sides. In spraying around edge, wipe chemical from floor with dry cloth. 1 1/4 gallons will treat approximately 125 square feet of heavy rugs or carpets and 150 square feet of light rugs or carpets.

**Upholstered Furniture:** Divan or overstuffed chairs. Remove cushions then pull forward. Treat under arms and bottom. Place back up and exercise care in spraying well down into all corners.

Spray back, bottom and sides. After spraying cushions, allow to dry, standing on edge, before replacing. Pad all legs of furniture when placed on treated carpet. Overstuffed chairs require 1 to 2 pints depending on size. The average size divan will require 5 to 6 pints.

**Washable Woolens and Drycleaned Clothes:** Make sure your woolens can be washed before doing so. If washable, do not use soap. Use a detergent made especially for laundering woolens. If washed with soap, re-treat. Otherwise, effectiveness remains after numerous washings and dry-cleanings.

LIFE-O-FABRIC CHEMICAL has been shown by laboratory tests to be retained by the fabric for an indefinite period of time. As a precautionary measure, we advise re-treating after 8 to 10 washings or drycleanings, or as indicated, for Moth and Carpet Beetles. For Mold and Mildew re-treat as needed.

To the best of our knowledge, LIFE-O-FABRIC CHEMICAL is not exactly duplicated by any other product now being manufactured and sold.
