DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FLEAS—Thoroughly wet the animal with water and apply YIPPEE, about three tablespoons for a medium size dog. Thoroughly work YIPPEE into the hair until a pronounced lather is formed over the entire body, rinse.

Lice—Apply in same manner as for fleas to kill motile or active stages of lice. To kill lice that may have hatched from eggs after washing, repeat in one week. Use additional applications as needed.

EAR MITES—Mites commonly occur in wax in the ears. Apply a few drops of YIPPEE (undiluted) in the ear so that it penetrates the wax and surrounding tissues. Irrigate with warm water. Repeat as necessary.

TICKS—Apply with dropper, or piece of cotton, YIPPEE undiluted directly on each individual American dog tick or Brown dog tick. Repeat the applications as necessary when animals acquire ticks.
