Solutions of GLD may be applied with a mop or sprayer. The loosened dirt and soil is best removed by rinsing with clear water, and then taken up with a mop or squeegee.

For non-resilient floors such as terrazzo, tile, marble, marbelettemagnesite, flagstone, terra cotta, granolithic, travertine, etc., mix one part of GLD with 20 to 40 parts of hot or warm water depending upon the amount of soil on the surface. If the floors are extremely soiled use 1 part to 10 parts of water until the floor has an improved appearance. After that a more dilute solution may be used.

For Resilient Surfaces such as rubber, linoleum, asphalt tile, plastic, cork, as well as hardwood sealed or varnish floors use 1 part GLD to 30 parts of hot or warm water. For oil soaked floors or for dance floors use 1 part GLD to 10 parts of hot water. Allow to remain on the surface for several minutes before taking up with mop or squeegee.


