
DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To Kill roaches, ants, VIII -  
waterbugs, silverfish, spiders, crickets, INDOORS

Dilute one pint of WILD with water to make one gallon and apply as a thorough spot treatment to all cracks, crevices, underneath sinks, behind pipes, around the base of all machinery, paying particular attention to dark areas in which roaches might hide or nest. Spray Ant trails and other localized areas infested with these pests. Contact as many insects as possible while spraying. Repeat treatment as required.

To Kill Carpet Beetles:

Dilute one pint of WILD with water to make one gallon. Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelves. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks: PET SLEEPING QUARTERS  
Dilute one pint of WILD with water to make one gallon. Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Application should be repeated as infestations warrant, and as reinfestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.



Comments

To Kill Flies, roaches and ants and Destroy Odors On Surfaces of Garbage Containers, Sewage and Garbage Pits:

Dilute one pint of WILD with water to make one gallon. Apply as a thorough spot treatment to the surface only. Do not use as a space spray. Avoid over spraying and waste.

USE FOR SPOT TREATMENTS ONLY WHEN APPLIED INDOORS OR GARBAGE OR STORAGE AREAS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, LICE AND  
ANT HILLS OUTDOORS: VIII - OUTDOORS

Dilute one pint WILD with water to make one gallon. For outdoors use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray surfaces of eaves, doors, windows or wherever these insects may enter the house. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

TO KILL FLEAS, AND ANTS OUTDOORS: VIII - OUTDOORS

Dilute one pint WILD with water to make one gallon. For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation. Spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet sills and runways. Repeat application as infestations warrant and as reinfestation occurs.

CAUTION
