DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Child Resistant Cap Instructions: To open, hold bottle firmly on a flat surface. With other hand, squeeze sides of cap at flat spots where indicated by arrows and turn counter clockwise. Avoid squeezing bottle while opening. To close, turn cap counterclockwise until tightly closed.

Important: Use only for toilet bowls. Contact with toilet lids, sinks, vanities, bathtubs, counter tops, bathroom fixtures, metals and other surfaces should be washed off immediately to avoid possible damage.

General Cleaning: Remove cap. Squeeze gently, directing bowl cleaner under rim and on sides of bowl. Replace cap. Brush clean and flush toilet. Rinse brush with clean water.

To Disinfect Bowls: Remove water from the bowl. Squeeze gently 1 oz. of bowl cleaner onto bowl brush. Clean entire unit, especially under rim at water outlets. Allow to remain 10 minutes. Flush and rinse out bowl brush with clean water. A preliminary cleaning is necessary for removal of heavy soil prior to disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
