The proposed amendment to the registration of the subject product, updating the precautionary labeling and storage and disposal statements, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Add the following statements to the precautionary labeling:

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Keep all aquariums covered during treatments.

- 2. In the Environmental Hazard section, change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

This DRYZIE® product is a finely divided powder which combines the flushing and killing powers of pyrethrin and piperonyl butoxide with the dehydrating principle of thermally oxidized hydrogen. It is relatively odorless and non-staining and may be used in accordance with directions in homes, restaurants, stores, hotels, offices, plants and warehouses. When used as directed, it is highly effective in controlling ants, roaches, silverfish, fleas, ticks, and dry wood termites.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician. Contain petroleum solvent. Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ANTS, SILVERFISH, COCKROACHES: Apply insectdry at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square feet of surface area. Treat on, around and behind molding, shelving in cabinets, baseboards, pipe openings, cracks, crevices, and openings where insects may enter premises. Repeat treatment as necessary and it is recommended on a monthly basis.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON CATS OR DOGS: Liberally apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly to the skin. Repeat as necessary. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at the rate of 1 ounce per 50 square feet. Repeat as necessary.

DRY WOOD TERMITES: To protect against entrance of dry wood termites use one pound per 1,000 square feet of floor or attic space. Use a squeeze bulb applicator or duster and reach all cracks, crevices, corners and service porches. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Keep away from moisture. Sweep up and dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in same manner.

CONTAINERS ONE POUND AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
