### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### INDOOR APPLICATION

The use of this product in food processing establishments should be confined to the operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing equipment should be cleaned with potable water before using.

Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying.

For maximum effectiveness, a combination of spot surface treatment and fogging is recommended.

**SURFACE SPRAYING** For control of cockroaches, palmate bugs, ants, silverfish, spiders, granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red flour beetles, sawtoothed beetle, drugstore beetles, meal worms, grain mites and cadidids. Apply at 1.5 pints per 1000 sq ft. Spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, under carpets, a porch, in the walls, in machinery, behind curtains and drawers. For use on floors, use a spray nozzle which will spray a fine mist. Apply to all surfaces, including walls, ceiling, and floor.

To control carpet beetles, spray edges of a rug and under the rug, including under pads. Moth and fleas, fly, and house flies, and infested areas. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days. Repeat treatment as needed.

To control fleas and brown dog ticks, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, rest areas, and other dog beds, arms, and legs, and dog crates, kennel areas, kennel yards, and the yard in the morning after a thorough treatment. Repeat treatment at 7-10 day intervals. Remove all infested articles from the house, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storage devices. After all infested articles have been treated, they should be stored in plastic bags.

**SPACE SPRAYING** Control house flies, mosquitoes, and other flying insects. Apply a fine mist of spray to all areas of the house, including fruit flies, gnats, mosquitoes, stable flies, Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal moths, and tobacco moths. Apply spray uniformly throughout the area to be treated.

**FOGGING** For control of flying insects in stages of the above. After drawing insecticide into feet of room, continue to fog until all insects are dead.

**ON LIVESTOCK** To control house flies, horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and other insects on the surface of the animal, spray the face, horse flies, and deer flies. Apply insecticide to the animal's body, including the head, neck, and legs. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days. To control blood-sucking lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal using a spray nozzle. Repeat every 7-10 days.

**ON PETS** This spray is safe for use on dogs, cats, and other pets. Apply liberally to the animal's body, including the head, neck, and legs. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days.

**OUTDOOR APPLICATION**  
**ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL** Apply as a fine mist to the vicinity of the house, a porch, and other areas where mosquitoes breed. Treat the undergrowth, in areas where mosquitoes breed, and other areas where they breed. Apply at a rate of 1.5 pints per 1000 sq ft. To control mosquitoes, use a fine mist of spray. Apply to all surfaces, including walls, ceiling, and floor. Treat a 300 foot square area with equipment to deliver 0.9 gallon per minute.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES** Store upright at room temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as paper or cloth. Remove waste.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** Flush the spray mixture down the water drain. Do not dispose of it in an open fire or water disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL** Do not reuse for equipment. Then offer for recycling, reuse, or sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Irritant to eyes. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets from spraying or surface applications.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED** Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by rubbing the back of the throat. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting if the person is unconscious.

**IF IRRITATED** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF ON SKIN** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to lakes, ponds, streams, tidal water, or other bodies of water. Do not apply directly to water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
