DIRECTIONS

Pour one-fourth container of RID-ROOT into toilet bowl. (Do not apply through sink or tub drains.) Flush immediately. Repeat as above until container is empty. For best results, apply at night when flow is at minimum.

OH! Pour entire contents into basement drain plug and flush with gallon of water.

AS A PREVENTATIVE

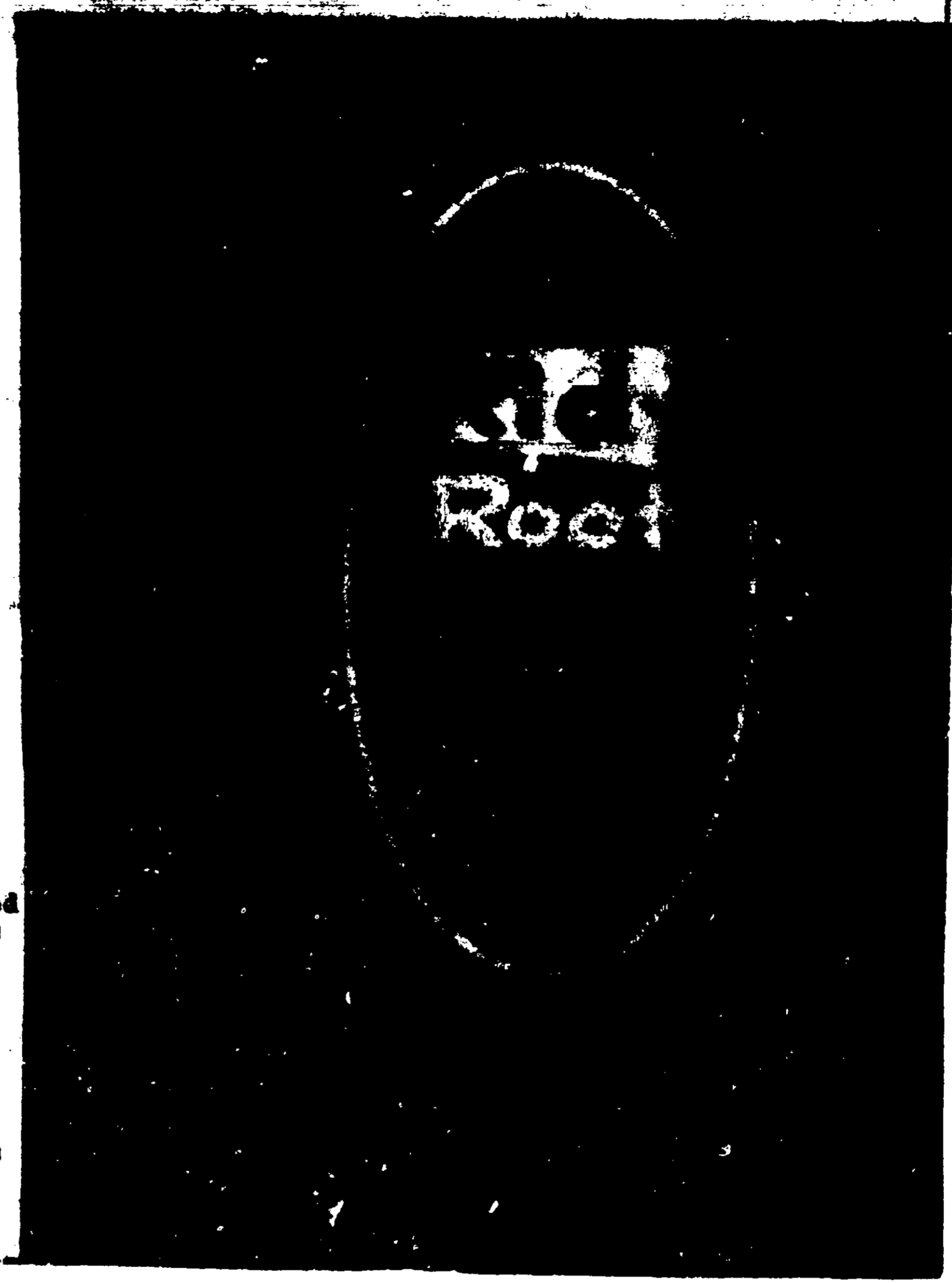
Repeat treatment every six months to maintain clear-flowing and efficient sewer lines.

Roots are usually cleared within a few hours. Severely blocked lines may require up to two days for restoration of normal flow. In extreme conditions, when partial blockage remains, it is advisable to repeat treatment the following day.

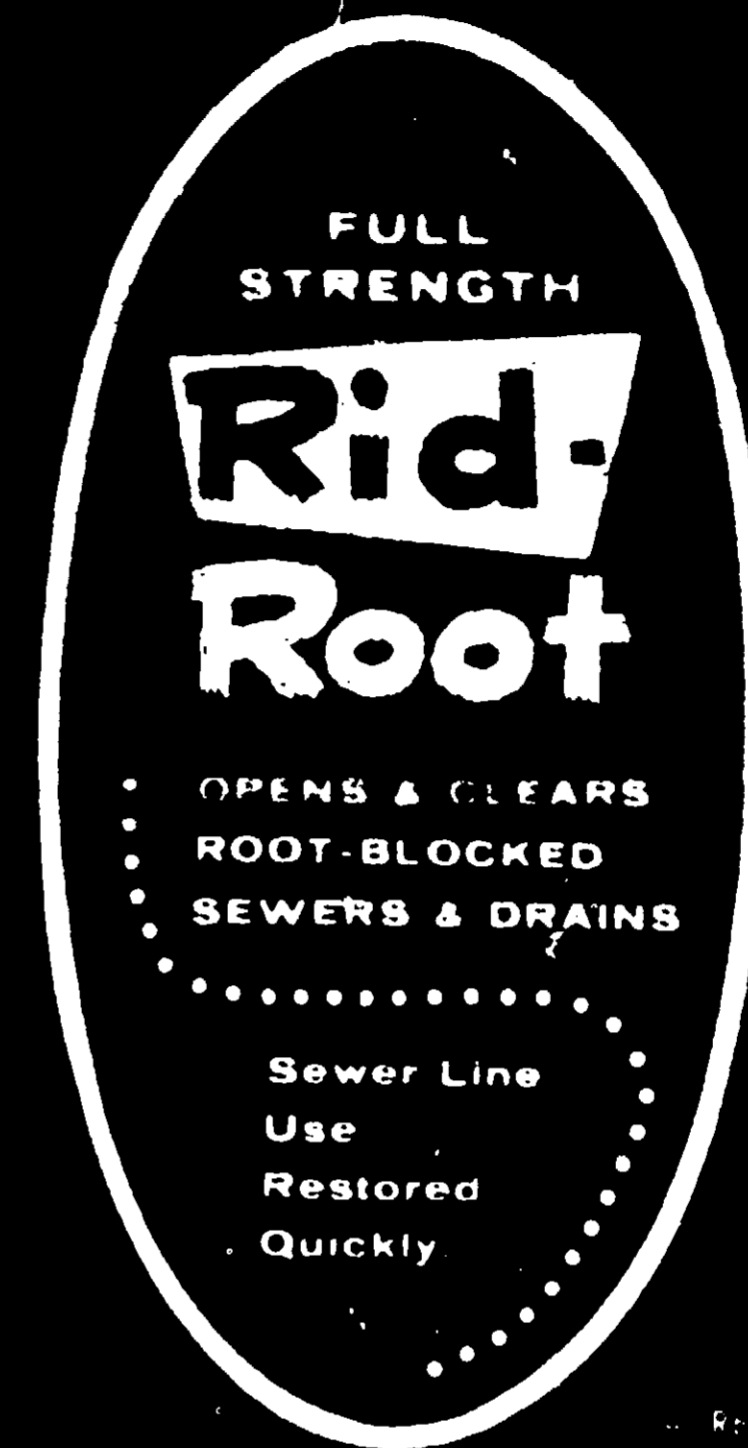
