

TO CONTROL AMBROSIA BEETLES, BARK BEETLES, AND WOOD BORERS IN LOGS

Add one gallon of Sonford BHC One to 28 gallons of Diesel fuel or No. 2 fuel oil and mix well. Water can also be used at the same rate of dilution, but the protection offered will not be as long lasting.

Spray entire surface of logs including cut ends. One gallon of spray should cover a maximum of 100 square feet of area. A power sprayer is recommended.

Logs should be sprayed within 24 hours of cutting.

For storage of logs for a period of several months spray the ground under the logs.

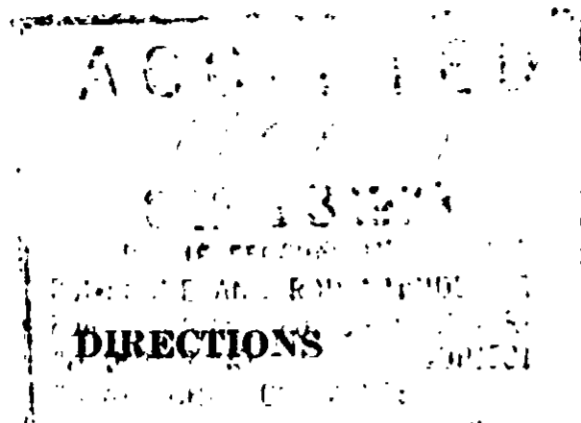
