DIRECTIONS

TO CONTROL AMBROSIA BETTLES, BARK BEETLES, AND WOOD BORERS IN LOGS

Add one gallon of Beetle Kil to 28 gallons of Diesel fuel or No. 2 fuel oil and mix well. Water can also be used at the same rate of dilution, but the protection offered will not be as long lasting.

Spray entire surface of logs including cut ends. One gallon of spray should cover a maximum of 100 square feet of area. A power sprayer is recommended.

Logs should be sprayed within 24 hours of cutting.

For storage of logs for a period of several months apray the ground under the logs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL


TO CONTROL AMBROS(A BEETLES IN LUMBER DURING SEASONING

Ambrosia beetles may attack green lumber during the first stages of seasoning if unprotected.

Add one gallon of Beetle Kil to each 160 gallons of anti-stain solution in the nip tank. Applicate well to form an emulsion. If fip tank is lift undisturbed for more than 15 minutes, agitate well. Immerse in this mixture in the dip tank by lumber is usually enough to keep the active ingredient in suspension.
