 - a. On the front panel, delete the statement revised the statement "See back panel for additinal Pre-cautioning statments" to "See back panel for additional precautionary statements".
 - b. On the side panel, place the paragraph on disinfection above the paragraph on deodorizing. Public health use directions comes before non-public health use directions.
 - c. Under "Disinfecting" indicate how the product must be removed from the treated surfaces after the recommended contact time. Refer to the DIS/TSS-15 enclosure, item 6.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.


