
Dear Mr. Zenon,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The statement "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" may be removed from the First Aid section.
2. The Signal word "CAUTION" within the First Aid box must be placed directly below the header "Precautionary Statements" as outlined in section 8 of the Label review manual. **Required Location: The signal word may only appear in three places on the label. It must appear on the front panel of the label immediately below the child hazard warning statement, in the precautionary labeling section immediately below the subheading "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and in the WPS posting statement if one is on the label.**

**For Control of Insect Nests:** The best time to spray the nest is in the early morning or early evening, when air temperature is cooler and most insects are in the nest and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if the air is still. Stand at a safe distance from the nest, not directly under it. Hold container upright at arms length, point the actuator at the nest and spray in the opening of the nest first. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. Treated insects may fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the nest after treatment will be killed. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest. Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame, preferably in a locked storage area. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Unused product may be disposed of by wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash or give to someone who can use the product. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Offer empty container for metal recycling, where available. In areas where recycling is not available, attach cap and dispose of in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
