DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Brush animals to remove loose dirt before treating.

If a sprayer is used, apply lightly over surface of animal, rubbing the hair against its natural lay while applying. Use one to two ounces per animal, depending on his size. Apply daily.

If wipe-on is desired, moisten turkish towel (15" x 15") with product. Rub moist towel vigorously over entire surface of animal, especially over legs, shanks, shoulders, facial area, and neck. Apply against lay of the hair, using one to two ounces daily in this manner. To avoid towel drying out, place in tight storage after using.

Horse sense for horse health - have horse examined periodically by a veterinarian.
