

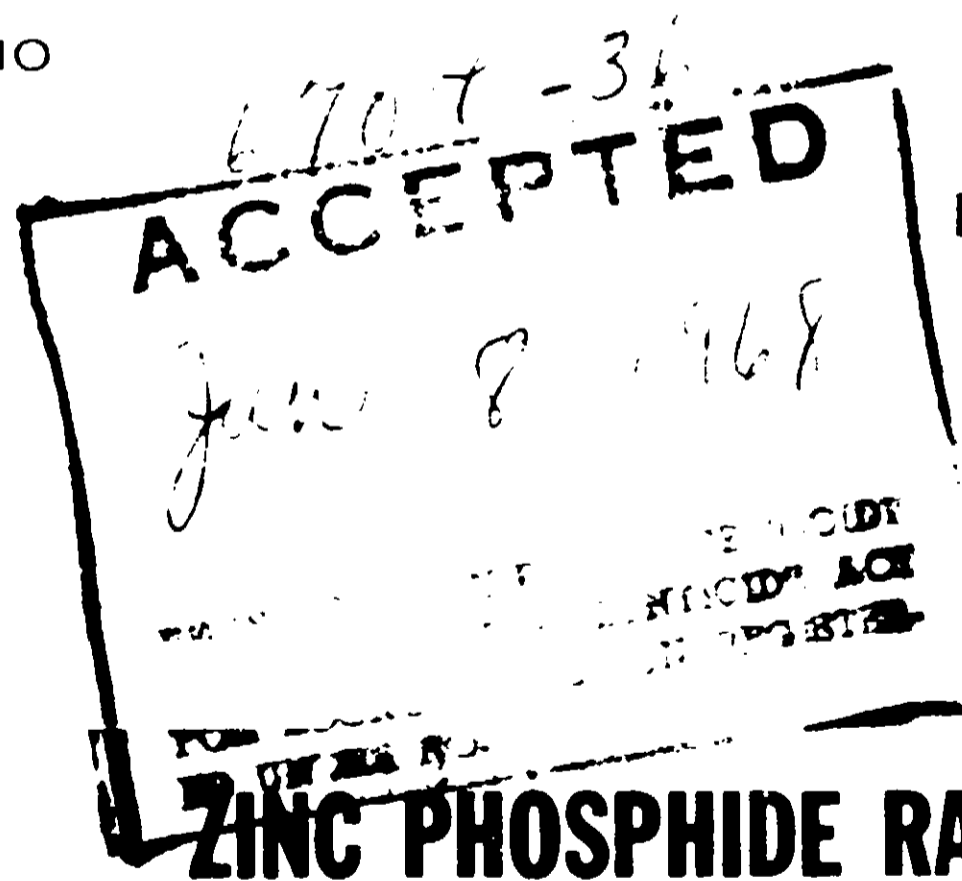

Zinc Phosphide 63%

Antimony Potassium Tartrate 24%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 13%

## ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Zinc Phosphide 63%

Antimony Potassium Tartrate 24%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 13%

**Due to Compaction, Can should be shaken before opening.**

**DIRECTIONS:** Use rubber gloves when mixing or placing zinc phosphide baits. Gradually mix entire contents of can with four pounds of bait, such as ground meat, fish, canned dog food or cat food, poultry mash, etc. Do not use foods which will be attractive to children, such as cookies, candy, nuts, etc. Place rounded teaspoon piles of bait at 8-10 foot intervals where rats feed, water or travel. Baits must be placed in tamper-proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets and domestic animals.

**NOTE:** Dogs and cats will actively search out baits of this type. Collect and destroy uneaten baits after completion of the control program.

**DIRECTIONS:** Use rubber gloves when mixing or placing zinc phosphide baits. Gradually mix entire contents of can with sixty-four pounds of bait, such as ground meat, fish, canned dog food or cat food, poultry mash, etc. Do not use foods which will be attractive to children, such as cookies, candy, nuts, etc. Place rounded teaspoon piles of bait at 8-10 foot intervals, where rats feed, water or travel. Baits must be placed in tamper-proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals.

**NOTE:** Dogs and cats will actively search out baits of this type. Collect and destroy uneaten baits after completion of the control program.

# PHIDE RAT POISON
