

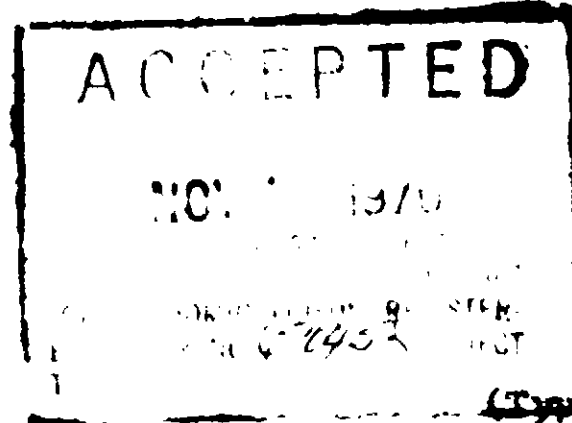

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

(Type size as prescribed by Interpretation 18)

Poisonous if swallowed or inhaled. Wear an approved respirator or use with adequate ventilation. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not store near food or feed. Keep container closed.

First aid: If swallowed, induce vomiting by stirring finger down throat with plenty of water or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. If unconscious, give artificial respiration. Call a physician.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, give artificial respiration. Call a physician.
