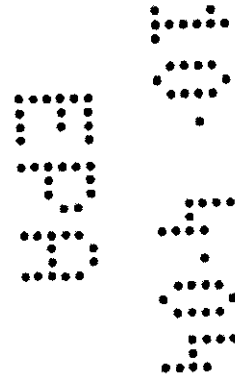

**Re: NOTIFICATION, TFM Bar (Reg. No. 6704-86) Change in packaging per PR Notice 98-10**

To whom this concerns:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify you of a change in packaging for the TFM Bar (Reg. No. 6704-86), in accordance with EPA PR Notice 98-10. The manufacturer, Bell Laboratories, Inc., has informed us that the packaging is now a plastic container, replacing a paper wrap. Specifically, an e-mail from technical director Peter S. Martin read,

*"Each 917 gram TFM bar is packaged in a transparent plastic container comprised of PET (Polyethylene terephthalate). The plastic package is equipped with a lid that is seated into the container upon closing. Before shipping, each container is sealed with cellophane tape to ensure closure in transit. A self-adhesive label is applied to the top face of the plastic box. The label is printed with text approved by EPA and the manufacturing lot number. Each plastic box is placed in a fiberboard master carton for shipment. Each master carton is labeled with the same label as the plastic boxes except the net contents are modified to reflect the quantity of the product contained in the master carton."*

Enclosed you will find Form 8570-1, Application for Pesticide. Sections I, II, and IV were completed as instructed. All criteria for notification required in section II, E. of PR Notice 98-10 have been met:

1. the dosage, concentration, frequency or method of application have not changed;
2. exposure is not increased, and there is no new or additional protective clothing or equipment requirements;
3. either before or after the proposed change, the product is neither subject to child resistant packaging (CPR), nor has the registrant voluntarily used CRP;



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4. the product is not a rodenticide;
5. no Worker Protection standard labeling statements are changed
6. the packaging size is not reduced to the point that the net contents of the package are smaller than the amount required by the directions for use or that a reduced package will require CRP;
7. the package size or other characteristics are not changed in a way that violates EPA-mandated restrictions imposed on a product;
8. no changes are made to bait stations, control stations, attractant stations or other packaging that houses the pesticide during its use.
