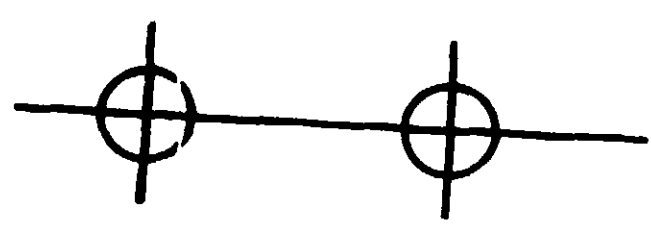

Wash or dry-clean garments before storing. Sprinkle crystals freely, between and over articles, using one ounce of Amway Perfumed Moth Crystals for every six cubic feet of tightly closed boxes, chests, trunks, or paper bags. For treating upholstered furniture and rugs, cover with Amway Moth Crystals so as to make the dosage equivalent to at least 1 lb.
